Admission Criteria

Casa Rene is a 10 bed short-term Crisis Residential program located in Kentfield, California. Casa Rene is licensed by Community Care Licensing and certified by the Department of Health Care Services and provides a short term crisis residential program for those experiencing a psychiatric crisis. Casa Rene is a voluntary adult program, and residents must be at least 18 years old to be accepted into the program.

Casa Rene Crisis Residential Program is operated under Drake House Social Rehabilitation, which is operated under the auspices of Buckelew Programs. Casa Rene partners with Marin County Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services to provide collaborative wellness and treatment services. The average stay is based on each client's assessed need, but may not exceed 30 days. Casa Rene is a certified Medi-Cal program

All referrals to Casa Rene will be made by Marin County Psychiatric Emergency Services (PES), who will be responsible for assessing a client's readiness for a short-term crisis residential program.

Referrals must meet the following requirements:

- Client must meet medical necessity.
- Client must be willing to enter the program voluntarily.
- Client is able to be safely and appropriately served in a setting less intensive than a psychiatric hospital.
- Client is able to be directed and engage in treatment.
- Client is ambulatory and not using specialized medical equipment that requires monitoring and/or prevents them from exiting the building independently, in case of emergency.

Exclusions to Admission to Casa Rene

- Client is actively suicidal or homicidal
- Client is incontinent
- Client has a communicable disease such as TB, or other airborne disease such as Influenza.
- Client is a known sex-offender or registered sex offender
- Client is a known or registered arsonist
